Topics include campaign finance disclosure, personal financial disclosure (PFD), and campaign material identification (paid for by) requirements.

Both candidates and committee treasurers are encouraged to attend.

Find answers to common questions such as:

1. **Campaign Finance:** How much cash can I receive from a person? What is an in-kind contribution? How much of my own money can I spend?
2. **Personal Financial Disclosure:** When must I file this form? What if I don't file? Whose information do I include?
3. **Campaign Materials:** What must I put on my signs and printed materials? What about campaign t-shirts?
